Mutual Recognition

Learning Verve recognises AQF Qualifications and Statements of Attainment issued by other RTOs under our 'Mutual Recognition' obligation. Participants who apply for RPL will need to provide evidence of their competence. Successful RPL applications will lead to exemptions from the identified unit/s of competency.

Entry requirements

The program is open to anyone currently working in a management, supervisory or team leader role. Participants will need to demonstrate that they have the requisite English language/literacy skills as well as the ability to analyse and solve problems.
